

Research on the **Vocational Guidance for Youth**

ABOUT 3,000 PEOPLE SURVEYED

The objective of the research has been to deepen the knowledge about the current situation of vocational guidance in **schools**. The total number of respondents was 2,833, including students, families and teachers from Croatia, Italy and Spain.







SOCIAL AND LABOR INSERTION

Parents play a crucial role in their children's career decisions.

More than 70% of fathers and mothers surveyed agree or strongly agree that improving career guidance would favour their social and labour market integration.



+ TRAINING AND MOTIVATION

Mothers, fathers and teachers recognize the value and need for professional guidance in schools. They consider that the lack of teacher training and the low motivation they perceive in students hinder vocational guidance.









CHOICE OF STUDIES

About 40% of the students are not sure what factors they should take into account when deciding on the studies they want to do to develop their professional future.

BREAK THE GAP

65% of teachers feel that they do not have sufficient training to guide their students on educational and career options.

The research shows that there is a big gap between the needs of students and the training of teachers.
