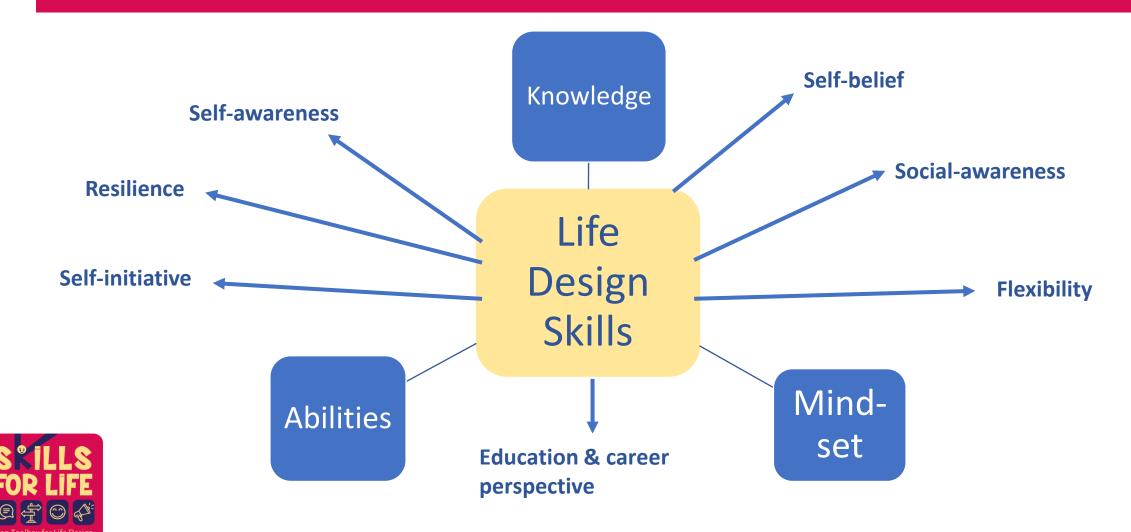

WHAT? The Orientation Toolbox for Life Design

1) Check4Skills: an online self-evaluation tool for youngsters

2) Play4Skills: a board game

3) Learn4Skills: a series of teaching modules

4) Train4Skills: a training for educators

5) Impact4Skills: an impact assessment tool

→ All available in DE, EN, IT, NL, RO language







IO1: Check4Skills and Play4Skills

Check4Skills: The online self-evaluation tool will help students to discover their strengths, weaknesses, priorities, interests and personality types, as well as to start considering how these may relate to different professional profiles.



Play4Skills: The **board game**, available both offline and online, aims to help students match their own characteristics and those of different job profiles and economic sectors in a playful way.

Alfa, is coordinating #Progettiamocilfuturo and Orientamenti, two projects funded by the European Social Fund which aim to provide information about the labour market, needed skills, study and job opportunities.

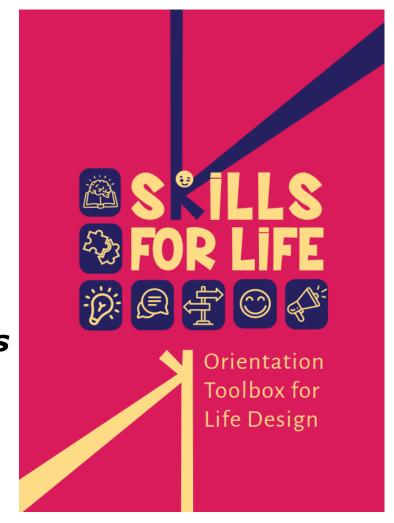
Said activities are developed and implemented with youngsters, education professionals and families.

On a theoretical level, this training will inroduce educators on the following topics:

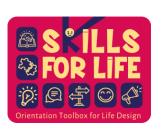
- · What do career guidance, orientation, and Life Design Skills mean? Common definition and approach
- . How can Life Design Skills be useful for your students and how important is it?

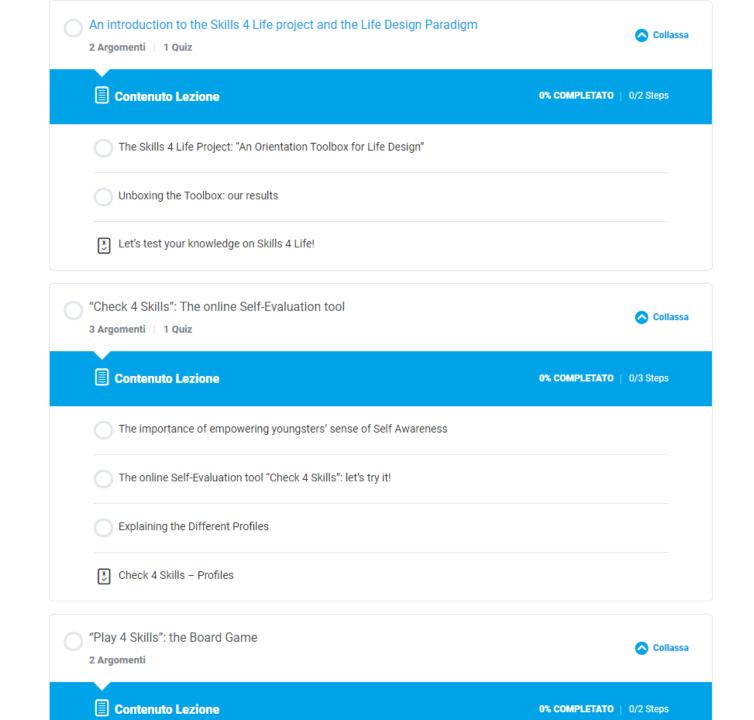
On a practical level, it will help educators to:

Why is this training important?

It is vital that Educators feel empowered and stay in control of what they are doing. This is one reason why the training is so important and why it is preferable that they deliver the Toolbox to their students, rather than an external person; being exceptionally meaningful individuals in the life of the youngsters they work with, educators are one of the most important audiences to address and support in their work



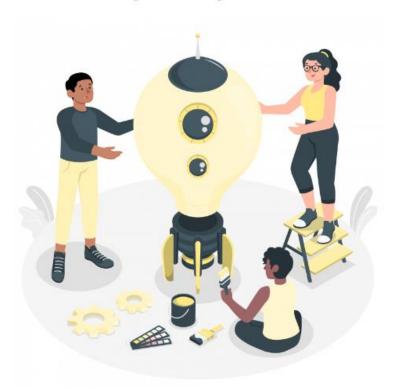

Project's Objectives



To contribute to young people's preparedness, the specific objective of this Strategic Partnership, co-financed by the Erasmus+ programme, is thus to empower teachers, youth workers, career guidance providers ('educators') to teach Life Design Skills to young people.

Between October 2020 and March 2023, the project consortium consisting of the **Goethe-Institut** (DE), Alfa Liguria (IT), Scoala de Valori (RO), Tracé Brussel (BE) and the City of Mannheim (DE), works towards this objective primarily by developing an 'Orientation Toolbox for Life Design' ready to use for educators.



How will we sustain Train4Skills

- Ready to use online/offline and accessible in 5 languages (Dutch, German, Italian, Romanian and English)
- Accessible on the website of the partner
- Train4Skills can be used as starting point to use the Skills for life toolbox.

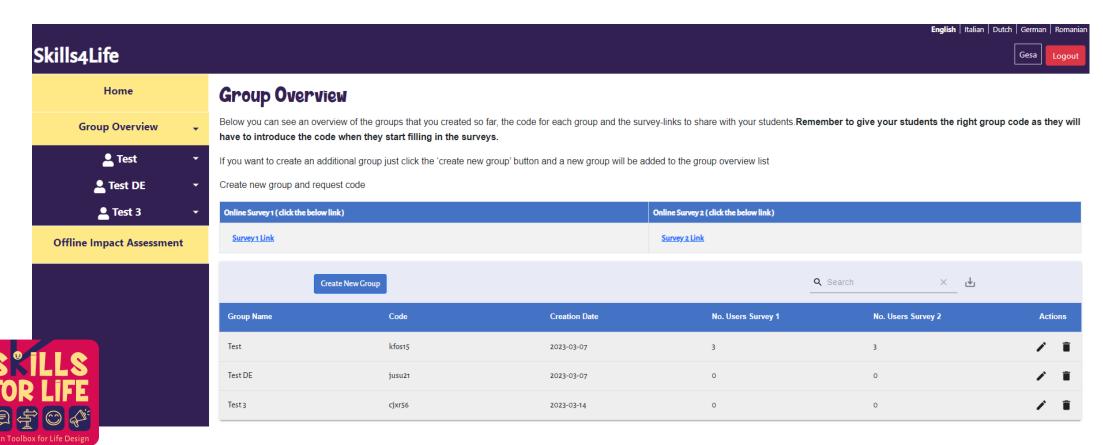




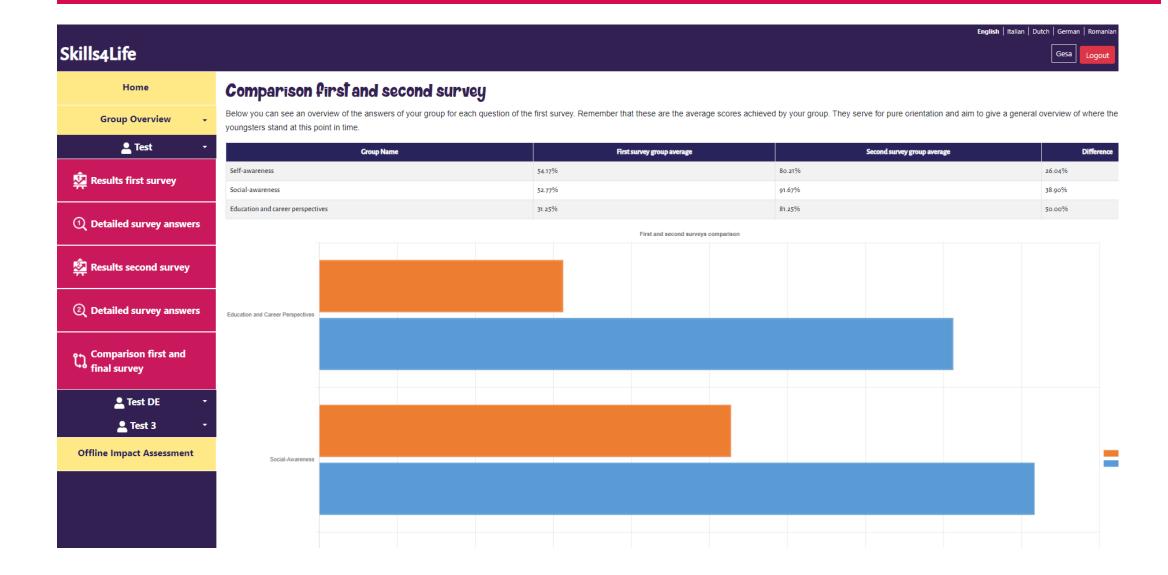

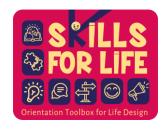
What we achieved

Who we are

StartNet Network Transition Education-to-Work

- In Italy: brings together schools, institutions, businesses, young people, and civil society to improve the transition from school to work for young men and women in Southern Italy.
- **In Europe:** connects **initiatives all across Europe** that empower young people on their personal and professional paths towards a successful transition to work.









Train4Skills Collaboration with Regional School Office of Basilicata

We organized 2 **one-day trainings** to present the toolbox. We reached total:

- 60 teachers
- 41 schools
- 2 online trainings for the online tools
- 2 follow-up webinars
- 2 pilot school classes



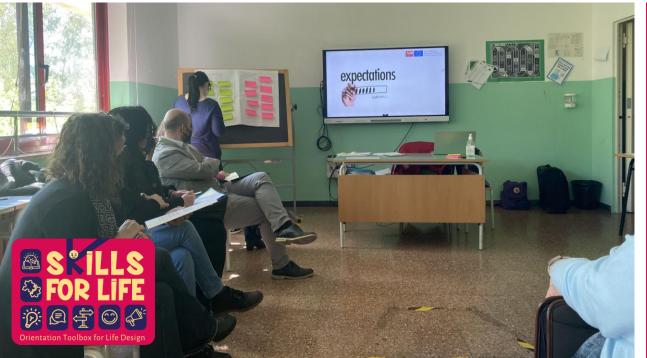












Train4Skills – Trainings for teachers

Learnings and Feedback about **Skills for Life Training**

Results of our survey with teacher who participated:

80% of teachers thought that the training was very useful

70% of teachers think they will use at least two of the tools

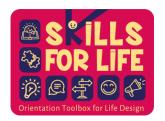

Interactive and based on the agency of the student

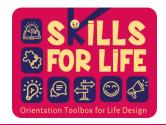
